I have had the privilege of working as Vice Chair of the IUPHAR Education Section since 2018, and interim Chair since late 2021. My vision for the role in the next term is to work with the Education Section, Pharmacology Education Project (PEP) and member pharmacology societies to:

- Lead the development of inclusive innovative educational resources and approaches, including eLearning, that support pharmacology education internationally.
- Ensure the financial and content viability of PEP and its relevancy worldwide.
- Develop international pharmacology education networks through organisation of regular meetings and conferences, including an Education Satellite symposium at World Congress of Pharmacology
- Engage with, support, and disseminate international pharmacology societies' education initiatives, for example the CSPT's Glossary of Pharmacological Terms, ASCEPT's Core Concepts, and BPS's Inclusive Pharmacology Education
- Strengthen connections with other Society sections

I believe I have the experience and passion to direct and guide this vision. As a member of the Pharmacology Research & Perspectives editorial board I wrote the author guidelines for the new Pharmacology Education and Innovation Series.

- Deputy Director of the IUPHAR PEP
- Education Lead on the International Scientific Committee for WCP2023
- A project lead for IUPHAR Core Concepts in Pharmacology Education
